



## INTERESTED IN A FREE COMPUTER?

### **NORTH BRENTWOOD IN COORPORATION WITH MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT CONNECTED DEVICES PROGRAM WILL PROVIDE COMPUTERS FOR QUALIFIED NORTH BRENTWOOD RESIDENTS – one device per household**

The following covered populations are eligible to receive devices.

- Households enrolled in the federal Affordable connectivity Program (ACP)
- Households participating in certain government assistance programs such as:
  - Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), formerly known as Food Stamps- Snap Card
  - Medicaid - Card
  - Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) – WIC card
  - Supplemental Security Income (SSI) -Benefits letter
  - Federal Public Housing Assistance (FPHA)
  - Veterans Pension and Survivors Benefit – Award letter or other proof
  - Free and Reduced – Price School Lunch Program or School Breakfast Program – Approval letter
  - Received a Federal Pell Grant in the current year – Award letter

Households that show proof of income of less than or equal to 200% of federal poverty level (see income guideline chart below. Proof page 1 of your tax return
