

PUBLIC NOTICE of Charter Amendment
October 3rd, 2022

In accordance with Md. Code Ann. Local Gov't § 4-304 and § 4-305

The Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article – Local Government 4–304. (a) (1) The legislative body of a municipality may initiate a proposed amendment to the municipal charter by a resolution that, except as otherwise provided in this subtitle, is adopted in the same manner as other resolutions in the municipality by a majority of all the individuals elected to the legislative body.

(2) BEFORE ADOPTING A RESOLUTION INITIATED BY THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF A MUNICIPALITY THAT PROPOSES AN AMENDMENT TO THE MUNICIPAL CHARTER, THE LEGISLATIVE BODY SHALL: Ch. 285 2018 LAWS OF MARYLAND

(I) HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED AMENDMENT; AND (II) GIVE AT LEAST 21 DAYS' ADVANCE NOTICE OF THE PUBLIC HEARING.

A CHARTER AMENDMENT RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF NORTH BRENTWOOD AMENDING SECTIONS 401(NUMBER, SELECTION, TERM), 501 (SELECTION AND TERM), AND 709 (ELECTION OF MAYOR AND COUNCILMEMBERS) TO REMOVE REFERENCES TO APPOINTMENT OF THREE BOARD MEMBERS BY COUNCILMANIC WARDS, AND TO CORRECT OR CLARIFY WHICH MAYORAL OR COUNCILMANIC SEATS ARE FILLED IN CERTAIN ODD AND EVEN NUMBERED YEARS: AND GENERALLY RELATING TO TOWN ELECTIONS AND THE ELECTED OFFICIALS
