Millions Available: Pepco Energy Assistance

Maryland Pepco customers facing challenges paying energy bills can take advantage of the millions of dollars allotted for the Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP). The application period opened July 1.

Eligible customers may apply for \$1,000-plus in LIHEAP funds. Before applying, review the program eligibility requirements, which have changed.

LIHEAP grant eligibility differs by state and is based on a customer's annual household income and size. To be eligible in Maryland, a customer's annual household income cannot exceed 175% of the federal poverty income guidelines. Homeowners, renters, roomers and subsidized housing tenants may be eligible. **Customers don't have to be behind on their bills to receive grants**.

Apply for energy assistance by calling the Office of Home Energy Programs at 800.332.6347 or through the Department of Human Services website: dhs.maryland.gov/office-of-home-energy-programs.


